Key Verse:

Philippians 2:2-4

Complete my joy by being of the same mind, having the same love, being in full accord and of one mind. Main Point/Key Takeaways:

Watch Activity video of the week.

Have them make a pray chain. Cut strips of paper into ½" or 1". Allow them the make a prayer chain. Each child can put prayer requests on the chain and then glue them together. Encourage them to put down requests for the family and the church. If the prayer requests get answered, have them write a date or how God answered the requests on the chain link that has the request.

Everyone one can do this. You will have to have enough pencils outside. They kids will have to use their bibles as a "desk".
